Feeding Guide

- Commence feeding rate at 150-250grams / head /day
- Locate lick away from watering points to avoid over-consumption and to encourage stock to graze out
- Where indicated these blocks contain Urea and may be toxic if taken in excess. Feed with adequate dry roughage. Do not feed to starving stock or any animals other than sheep or cattle
- It is recommended that sheep do not have access to lick with Urea higher than 10% and especially where cravings have been shown

Features Include

- ✓ A **moderate** protein meal – **moderate** grain inclusion with consumption rates above the Low Grain Production Mix but below a full grain pellet or ration
- ✓ Palatable supplement providing support above maintenance levels for getting stock on rising plane of nutrition
- ✓ Suitable for bulls and heifers prior to joining and for larger weaners when pasture is green
- ✓ Contains Monensin to improve growth rates and feed conversion efficiency
- ✓ \$20 per tonne to add Monensin
